- Tychicus: a beloved brother & faithful fellow servant in the Lord
- Onesimus: our faithful & beloved brother who is one of you
- Aristarchus, Mark & Justus: fellow workers for the kingdom of God
- Epaphras: one of you, a servant of Christ Jesus, always struggling on your behalf in his prayers
- Luke: the beloved physician
- Paul's greetings: to the brothers & sisters at Laodicea, Nympha & the church in her house

- Paul's instructions: read this letter & the letter from Laodicea
- Paul's charge to Archippus (thru the Colossians): fulfill the ministry you've received in the Lord
- Paul's finals words: remember my chains & grace be with you
- 2. Faithful, Beloved & Fellow Servants in the Lord:
- are lovingly devoted to one another thru Christ-centered humility, team effort & prayer
- are "hard-working" workers for the kingdom of God –
 who are not defined by our failures

meet together as local churches –
