**TRUSTING YOUR HEAVENLY FATHER FOR ALL  
IN SEEKING HIS WAY ABOVE ALL**

Matthew 6:25-34

As those who follow Jesus as Lord of the kingdom of heaven, we don't belong **to** this world. We belong to the age to come. But we do belong **in** this world now and in Matthew 6:25-34 our Lord urges us to **trust our heavenly Father to provide us with all that we need in this life as we seek His way above all else.**

**I. DON'T WORRY:**

**Trust your heavenly Father for all your earthly needs** (vss. 25-30)

\*You are much more important to God than your basic needs—and there is more to life! (25)

\*Example 1: Life and food and the birds our Father feeds (26-27)

\*Example 2: Body and clothing and the lilies our Father clothes (28-30)

**II. DON'T WORRY:**

**Pursue God's kingdom life above all, knowing He'll provide**  
(vss. 31-33)

\*Reject the unbelieving, pagan pre-occupation with material things (31-32)

\*Pursue first things first: God's kingdom concerns and way of life (33)

**III. DON'T WORRY:**

**Be content to spend today's energy on today's kingdom tasks** (vs. 34)

\*Don't be anxious about tomorrow's cares (34a)

\*Today's cares are enough to concern us (34b)
